3.0 CONTRACTOR AGREEMENT

Ketek considers health and safety is amongst our highest priority. We are committed to providing a work environment that strives to protect the health and safety of our Contractors, Sub-Contractors, Clients, Suppliers and our Employees. For the purpose of this Agreement Contractor/Sub-Contractor will be referred to as Contractor.

Contractors must have a safety program that is actively supported by the Contractor's top management team. Our Contractors must, as a minimum:


- Abide by all Ketek health and safety rules in performance of work on our work sites;
- Abide by all applicable government rules, regulations and laws;
- The Contractor shall not employ or retain anyone as a Sub-Contractor to perform any part of its obligations under this agreement without the written consent of the Vice President. The Contractor will be required to undergo a pre-qualification process with its Sub-Contractor, which meets or exceeds Ketek Policies, Standards and/or Work Procedures;
- All Contractors must complete and submit the Contractor Selection and Management documents for approval prior to commencing work at any Ketek work site;
- At Ketek's request, the Contractor will participate in a pre-startup safety review (kick off);
- The Contractor is to maintain an active WCB account;
- The Contractor shall maintain liability insurance coverage including property damage in an amount of not less than Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) per occurrence for the full length of the time of the contract;
- The Contractor shall maintain in good standing all permits and licenses required by any authority having jurisdiction over the business of the Contractor. This shall be done at the expense of the Contractor unless mutually agreed by Ketek; and
- All Contractors must appoint competent supervisors and ensure their workers are adequately trained. Proof of training shall be available upon request.

It is our policy to seek continuous improvement in our environmental performance. We are committed to maintaining environmentally sound business operations, and to contributing to the common effort to protect the natural and workplace environment. At all of our sites, we expect our Contractor to:

- Ensure that, at a minimum, all products and services comply with applicable environmental rules, regulations and laws;
- Actively work to meet or exceed all applicable environmental and materials handling policies;
- Minimize waste and then reuse or recycle as much as possible; and
- Assess the environmental impact of any new processes or products intended for use in advance.

Every twelve months from the date the Contractor is approved to work, a review will be undertaken to ensure HSE performance is continually meeting or exceeding Ketek's expectations. This review will include:

- An update and overview of the Contractor safety statistics;
- Updated WCB Clearance Letter, rate statements, and liability insurance coverage;
- A review of any significant risk areas related to the work being performed;
- Changes to the Contractor safety program;
- COR re-certification;



- F212 Contractor Work Evaluation; and
- Other information as desired by Ketek.

The Contractor will provide a detailed F178 Contractor Risk Mitigation Plan at the discretion of Ketek, if any requirements in part with the Contractor Selection and Management Procedure cannot be met.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Contractors are required to participate in Ketek toolbox meetings, safety meetings, Hazard and Risk Assessments, planning and post project reviews.
- 2. Contractors are required to submit daily safety documentation, including inspection reports, to the Ketek Site Supervisor daily.
- 3. The Contractor has adequate procedures for critical safe work system, for the work being performed. Critical safe work plans and permits are to be submitted to the Ketek Site Supervisor.
- All Contractors must ensure its Employees are suitably fit for duty to perform all aspects of their work. All Contractors must ensure Employees are trained and competent to perform all aspects of their work.
- 5. All Unplanned Events, including near miss reports, must be submitted to Ketek site Supervisor immediately, or as soon as practical. All Unplanned Events must be investigated and a copy of the investigation provided to Ketek within five days.
- 6. Each Contractor must provide current SDS for all controlled products used on site. All workers must have WHMIS 2015 training.
- 7. Housekeeping must be maintained on a regular basis throughout the shift.
- 8. Charged/inspected fire extinguishers must be provided and properly secured in all site offices, vehicles, storage facilities and other areas as dictated by Ketek. Fire Extinguishers must be clearly visible and readily available.
- 9. First aid kits, eye washes and other equipment as required by the Code or listed in Ketek's LPP must be available at the workplace, inspected regularly as scheduled and readily accessible.
- 10. Substandard conditions and practices will not be tolerated.
- 11. The Contractor agrees to abide by the requirements outlined in P032 Business Conduct and Ethics, and P033 Corruption Management.
