One of the most important considerations when installing a well pump is the splice. Ketek's splicing method has been proven through the testing and operation of hundreds of pumps. Prior to leaving our facility, the pump is submerged and the splice is "meggered." Meggers are used to troubleshoot a well pump motor's resistance to ground. It is a far superior testing method than using a standard ohmmeter.

Every pump sold by Ketek is tested in a 90m³ test tank and compared in both flow and pressure to the factory pump curve. A report can be provided upon request.
